Don't let Sydney Water trash Wolli Bluff



The Wolli Creek Valley is inner South-West Sydney's environmental gem, a precious remnant of the pre-European landscape, but Sydney Water plans to locate a sewage Odour Control Unit (OCU), a large intrusive piece of Infrastructure, at Wolli Bluff, astride the popular Two Valley Trail, right at the valley's eastern gateway.

Wolli Creek Preservation Society is campaigning to have the OCU relocated to a vacant, government-owned nonbushland site nearby – a site which has many advantages over Sydney Water's proposed location.
